Description/Requirements: FORA is a Chicago nonprofit providing high dosage tutoring and other empowerment services to refugee youth based in the West Ridge neighborhood of Chicago. Fellows are involved in delivering cutting-edge High Dosage Tutoring (“HDT”) to 60-65 formerly pre-literate SLIFE (Students with Limited or Interrupted Formal Education) refugee students in grades K through 12. The goal is to ensure that educational gaps are filled and that the students catch up to grade level. Timeslots that are available are 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., Mondays through Fridays. We would like fellows to come consistently every weekday during the same times each day to the extent possible. As you will be teaching reading in English to pre-literate students, you need to be able to fluently read in English. If you can read well in English, you have the educational qualifications for this job. We value patience, kindness, wellness, intercultural connection, a passion for learning and a determined resilience... and modeling these values for others. All tutors must undergo a formal background check to work with the children.
